### ***UK Tidal API - Foundation***

This module, in combination with the Terms of Use for API Access, set out the terms on which the United Kingdom Hydrographic Office (the "**UKHO**", "**we**", "**our**" or "**us**") makes data (the "**Data**") available (on a subscription basis) to you, the entity or person entering into these Terms as a developer ("**you**" or "**your**"), through an Application Programming Interface (the "**API**") for the purposes of developing web or mobile applications, for use by end users authorised by you (the "**End Users**"), on any platform, such that End Users are able to access the Data (the "**Solution**").

Your access to, and use of, the Data through the API is subject to the Terms (as that term is defined in the Terms of Use for API Access) and all applicable laws and regulations.
