

ADMIRALTY e-NP Service**End-user Licence Agreement for ADMIRALTY e-NP Service
(Disk based and/or Download)****1. THE PARTIES**

The UKHO The UK Hydrographic Office, for and on behalf of the UK Secretary of State for Defence, of Admiralty Way, Taunton, Somerset, TA1 2DN, United Kingdom.

"The Licensee" or "You" The user of the Software or Data who has confirmed its acceptance of the terms set out in this Licence pursuant to Clause 2.

2. PURPOSE

2.1. The terms set out in this Licence will govern the Licensee's Use of the Software or Data as defined in Clause 3 and is not an agreement for the sale of the Software or Data to the Licensee. Nothing in this Licence shall be deemed to transfer any rights, other than the licence grant contained herein, including any intellectual property rights in the Software or Data to the Licensee.

2.2. Consent: by using the ADMIRALTY e-NP Service, you are signing to the Terms of the e-NP Service and consenting to the way the Service should be used and the restrictions it includes.

2.3. Depending on the manner in which the Licensee accesses and/or receives the Data or Software, it confirms its agreement to the terms and conditions set out in this Licence either by:

2.3.1. clicking the "I accept" button to proceed with the installation where downloading or installing electronically; or

2.3.2. breaking the seal securing any CD or other physical media on which the Data or Software is stored where obtaining a hard copy of the Data or Software; or

2.3.3. otherwise continuing to Use the Data or Software.

If you do not agree with the terms of this Licence you must not use the Data or Software and must either return the hard copy of the Data or Software to your supplier and/or delete any electronic version of the Data or Software from your systems.

3. DEFINITIONS

In this Licence the following words shall have the following meanings:

ADMIRALTY Products means those products sold by the UKHO and listed in its publication NP131 as updated from time to time.

Authorised Users means the Licensee, those persons notified to the UKHO by the Licensee's nominated vessel representative and the supplier of the Software to the Licensee.

Data means any digital publication data provided and licensed by the UKHO under this Licence, including any updates, new versions, or replacements subsequently provided, for which the Licensee has purchased a Permit, including any accompanying documentation.

Digital Licensing Certificate means the certificate setting out the Licensee's details and details of the Data which the Licensee is licensed to use

Permit means the electronic product key supplied by the UKHO and used to give the Licensee access to the Data.

Software means the e-NP software including any accompanying documentation, text or security keys required to decrypt the software for display and customer service and any enhancements, revisions or modifications to the same.



Third Party Products means any non-ADMIRALTY Products obtained by the Authorised User via the Software. Use means to load, install or run the Data or Software on the Workstations, or for the supplier of the Data or Software to do the same remotely for installation and set up purposes on behalf of the of the Licensee.

4. GRANT AND SCOPE OF LICENCE

4.1. The UKHO hereby grants the Licensee a perpetual, non-exclusive, non-transferable and royalty free licence to:

4.1.1. Use, and permit Authorised Users to Use, the Software and the Data on Workstations on the Licensed Vessels;

4.1.2 Use and, permit Authorised Users to access the Data remotely in preparation for use on such Licensed Vessel provided that the Data is not used on such Licensed Vessel at the same time or on more than the maximum number of Workstations specified in clause 7.2.

4.1.3 make, subject to the restriction set out at clause 7.3 of this Licence, hard copies of a limited selection of the Data; and

4.1.4. make one working copy of the Data and the Software for backup purposes only, such copy to be subject to all terms and conditions of this Licence.

4.2. The Licensee agrees to ensure that the Authorised Users are made fully aware of, understand and agree to abide by the terms of this Licence before they are allowed Use of the Data or Software. The Licensee accepts full responsibility for the acts or omissions of its Authorised Users.

4.3. The licence granted in this clause 4 does not entitle the Licensee to use any other ADMIRALTY Products or Third Party Products (whether obtained by the Licensee via the Use of the Software or otherwise) and all such ADMIRALTY Products and/or Third Party Products will be subject to the Licensee's acceptance of their respective end user licence or other terms and conditions required for the use of such products.

5. USE OF e-NP SOFTWARE

5.1. To enable the Licensee to use the Software the UKHO may place a 'cookie' onto the Licensee's workstation. Details of how and why the UKHO uses cookies to enable the Licensee to use the Software can be found at <http://www.ukho.gov.uk/pages/PrivacyPolicy.aspx>

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

6.1. All intellectual property rights in the Data and Software shall remain the property of the British Crown, the UKHO or its licensors and suppliers. The Licensee shall acquire no intellectual property rights in the Data or Software save as otherwise expressly provided in this Licence (including without limitation the Data and Software and/or any intellectual property rights).

6.2. The Licensee undertakes that all material (including without limitation the Data and Software and/or any Intellectual Property rights) belonging to or under the control of the UKHO to which the Licensee gains access or receives directly or indirectly as a result of the operation of this Licence shall not be used or accessed by the Licensee, its Authorised Users or any of its employees or any other person acting on its behalf for any purpose other than as set out in this Licence.

6.3. The Licensee shall give prompt notice to the UKHO if the Licensee becomes aware of any unauthorised use or exploitation of the whole or any part of the Data or Software by any third party and shall procure that Authorised Users, its employees or any other person acting on its behalf do likewise.

6.4. All copies of Data or Software made by the Licensee or its Authorised Users shall be the property of the UKHO regardless of the format of the copy.

7. RESTRICTIONS

7.1. The Licensee confirms that the rights set out at clause 4 constitute the entire licence granted to the Licensee and that this clause 7 is not exhaustive and does not operate to prejudice the legal rights of the UKHO or to exclude or limit the applicability of the general law.

7.2. The Licensee shall only be permitted under this Licence to install the Data on a maximum of 3 Workstations



on any Licensed Vessel. Further licences may be purchased by the Licensee if additional usage is required.

7.3. Any copies of the Data and Software in the Licensee's possession whether hard copies or electronic copies must not be sold, hired or transferred in any way to a third party without the express permission of UKHO, and shall not be used for navigation.

7.4. The Licensee undertakes:

7.4.1. subject to clause 4.1.2 not to copy the Data or Software;

7.4.2. not to rent, lease, sub-license, loan, translate, merge, adapt, vary or modify the Data or Software;

7.4.3. not to make alterations to, or modifications of, the whole or any part of the Data or Software nor permit the Data and Software or any part of it to be combined with, or become incorporated in, any other programs;

7.4.4. not to load the Data or Software on to a network server for the purposes of distribution to one or more computer(s) on that network or to affect such distribution (such use requiring a separate licence);

7.4.5. not to disassemble, de-compile, reverse engineer or create derivative works based on the whole or any part of the Data or Software nor attempt to do any such things except where explicitly permitted under local law;

7.4.6. to keep all copies of the Data and Software secure and to maintain accurate and up-to-date records of the number and locations of all copies of the Data and Software;

7.4.7. to supervise and control use of the Data and Software and ensure that the Data and Software is used by the Authorised Users, employees and representatives of the Licensee in accordance with the terms of this Licence;

7.4.8. to include the copyright notice of the UKHO on all entire and partial copies of the Data and Software in any form; and

7.4.9. not to provide, or otherwise make available, the Data or Software in any form, in whole or in part (including, but not limited to, program listings, object and source program listings, object code and source code) to any person without prior written consent from the UKHO.

8. TERM AND TERMINATION

8.1. The UKHO may terminate this Licence immediately on written notice if:

8.1.1. the Licensee commits a material or persistent breach of the Licence; or

8.1.2. the Licensee's financial position is such that its directors, shareholders or creditors take or are entitled to take steps to institute formal insolvency proceedings of a type provided for by the Insolvency Act 1986 (or any similar or analogous legislation, whether under English law or otherwise), including without limitation administration, liquidation, administrative receivership, receivership, voluntary arrangement, scheme of arrangement or bankruptcy, or if the Licensee is unable to pay its debts within the meaning of section 123 of the Insolvency Act 1986.

8.2. The UKHO may terminate this Licence for any reason by giving the Licensee not less than 90 days' written notice.

8.3. Upon termination of this Licence the Licensee shall return or destroy all copies, including partial copies, of the Data and Software supplied to it under this Licence.

9. VARIATION

9.1. The UKHO reserves the right to amend the provisions of this Licence. Details of any such amendments, and the date from which they will become effective, shall be notified on the website

<https://www.admiralty.co.uk/digital-services/admiralty-e-nautical-publications> from time to time and the Licensee should regularly check the site for updates. The terms of this Licence shall be deemed to have been varied from the date on which they are updated on that site.

10. GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

10.1. The General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/69 and Data Protection Act 2018 (together the "data protection legislation") applies to personal data relating to individuals acting as sole traders, employees, partners, and company directors wherever they are individually identifiable and the information relates to them as an individual rather than as the representative of a legal person (e.g. a name, corporate email address relates to a particular individual and is therefore personal data).



10.2. The content of any email using those details is only considered as personal data if it includes information which reveals something about that individual or has an impact on them.

10.3. Under these End User Terms and Conditions, as an ADMIRALTY e-NP Service User, you are not authorised to use the personal details of your customers to gain commercial advantage.

10.4. You confirm that where necessary in accordance with data protection legislation you have obtained freely given, fully informed, unambiguous and specific consent to process any personal data and you fully indemnify UKHO for any loss suffered in relation to any breach of the data protection legislation resulting from or in connection with your use of the ADMIRALTY e-NP Service.

10.5. By using the ADMIRALTY e-NP Service, you are consenting to the way the Service should be used and the restrictions it includes.

11. DISCLAIMER

11.1. The UKHO shall make all reasonable efforts to ensure that the Data and Software are accurate and error free. The Licensee acknowledges that some Data will be obtained by the UKHO from third parties that the UKHO has no control over and that the UKHO will not be responsible for the content or accuracy of such third party data. In these circumstances separate licence terms may apply and the Licensee should review these carefully before agreeing to use the data to which those third party terms apply

11.2. Other than for fraud, fraudulent misrepresentation or death or personal injury caused by the UKHO's negligence (unless this can be excluded under local law), the UKHO's total aggregate liability under or in connection with this Licence whether in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise will be limited to the price paid by the Licensee for the Data or the Permit, whichever is the greater.

11.3. The Licensee acknowledges that it is responsible for complying with local laws and regulations of the jurisdiction in which it uses and imports the Data or Software. The Data or Software should not be accessed or imported in any jurisdiction where for any reason the use or availability of the Data or Software is prohibited. UKHO does not represent that the Data or Software complies with laws in all jurisdictions.

11.4. The UKHO's liability for infringement of third party intellectual property rights shall be limited to breaches of rights subsisting in the UK.

11.5. This Licence sets out the full extent of the UKHO's obligations and liabilities in respect of the supply of the Data or Software. In particular, there are no conditions, warranties, representations or other terms, express or implied, that are binding on the UKHO except as specifically stated in this Licence. Any condition, warranty, representation or other term concerning the supply of the Data or Software which might otherwise be implied into, or incorporated in, this Licence, or any collateral contract, whether by statute, common law or otherwise, is hereby excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law.

11.6. Nothing in this Licence is intended to affect any statutory rights that you may have if you are receiving this Licence as a consumer and are using the Data or Software for private use and not for commercial use.

11. GENERAL

11.1. Assignment and Sub-Licensing: Save as otherwise provided in this Licence the Licensee is not entitled to assign or sub-license to any third party any of its rights or obligations under this Licence without the UKHO's prior written consent. The UKHO shall be entitled to assign or contract-out its rights and obligations under this Licence to any person, but the UKHO shall give notice of such assignment in writing to the Licensee.

11.2. Severability: If any part, term or provision of this Licence not being of a fundamental nature be held illegal or unenforceable the validity or enforceability of the remainder of this Licence shall not be affected.

11.3. Rights of third parties: No right is granted to any person who is not a party to this Licence in their own right and the Parties declare that they have no intention to grant any such right.

11.4. Entire Agreement: This Licence supersedes and cancels all previous agreements and working arrangements whether oral or written, express or implied between the Parties in respect of or in connection with the matters referred to in this Licence.

11.5. No Waiver: No waiver of any term or condition of this Licence shall be effective unless made in writing and signed by the Party against which enforcement of the waiver is sought. The waiver of any breach of any term or any condition of this Licence shall not be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of a term or condition of the same or different nature.



11.6. Governing Law: This Licence shall be governed by and construed and interpreted in accordance with English Law and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts except that either party may seek an interim injunction or other urgent relief in any court of competent jurisdiction. It is hereby agreed for the benefit of UKHO that the submission to the jurisdiction of the English Courts shall not (and shall not be construed so as to) limit the right of UKHO to bring legal proceedings in any other court of competent jurisdiction including without limitation the courts having jurisdiction by reason of the Licensee's domicile. Legal proceedings by UKHO in any one or more jurisdictions shall not preclude legal proceedings by it in any other jurisdiction whether by way of substantive action, ancillary relief, enforcement or otherwise.
